Math:

We are starting the year in Math with place value. We will start off with a diagnostic test to see what we know and what we need to work on, then move to reading and writing multi-digit numbers.

Reading:

"Flora and Ulysses" will be the story of the week. We will discuss our essential question, complete a knowledge map, learn new vocabulary, dictate sentences,

work with context clues, learn how to cite text evidence.

Science:
